# COVID-19 – TERMS, CONDITIONS, & RESTRICTIONS

Subject to change - dependent on the COVID-19 restrictions in place at the time of, and during, the event.

- Face masks must be always worn, except when swimming.
- Physical distancing is encouraged wherever possible.
- Spectators will not be permitted entry to the facility.
- No congregating on the pool deck at any time during the competition.
- Wash and dry your hands or use hand sanitiser regularly.
- Abide by any other directives from the venue staff.

# **COVID-19 Entry Terms and Conditions**

I declare that, at the time of entering:

- I am not currently awaiting results for a COVID-19 test, nor have I tested positive for COVID-19
- I am not currently classed as a household contact of a COVID-19 case
- I am not currently showing symptoms of COVID-19

I acknowledge that, should I:

- Test positive for COVID-19, or
- Be classed a household contact of a COVID-19 case, or
- Display symptoms of COVID-19, or
- Be waiting on results from a COVID-19 test,

before, during, or after the competition, I will contact the event organiser immediately, and withdraw from racing whilst self-isolating.

In entering this competition, I acknowledge that the competition is subject to the restrictions imposed under the COVID-19 Protection Framework at the time of the event. If such restrictions change in the lead up to the competition, I acknowledge that this event may be cancelled.

# STUDENT ELIGIBILITY

**School Coordinators** are to complete, all required details including relay names, on the entry form provided and email to admin@swimotago.org close of entries.

- Students must be Year 9-13 (SWID excepted) and be enrolled full-time at school.
- Students with a physical disability "SWPD" or an intellectual disability "SWID" may compete. Schools must sign students' authorisation to compete in SWPD events.
- There is no limit on the number of individual or relay entries students, or the school, can enter.
- There are no qualifying times for this competition.

# **ENTRY DETAILS**

Students are to enter their individual events via **Fast Lane** and relay entries are to be submitted via email on the entry form provided no later than the closing date.

All entry fees (individual and relay entries) will be **invoiced to the school** and payable within 7 days by direct debit to Swimming Otago Inc. account number 02-0900-0071226-00. Receipts can be issued upon request.

There will be **no refunds for withdrawals after the closing date**, unless the student is withdrawing for medical reasons, in which case a medical certificate must be submitted for consideration.

**Late entries** may be accepted; however, they will have the status of 'exhibition' meaning no awards or records can be obtained.

#### **VOLUNTEERS**

Volunteers are vitally important to the successful running of any event so each school is asked to provide at **least one timekeeper and/or accredited swimming official, for every two students.** This can be a parent or teacher or capable student. Names are to be emailed to <a href="mailto:admin@swimotago.org">admin@swimotago.org</a> no later than Wednesday 25<sup>th</sup> May if they have not been provided on the entry form.

#### **CHAMPIONSHIP CONDITIONS**

These Championships will be deemed a Development Meet and will be swum under Swimming NZ rules, policies, and regulations with the following specific conditions and criteria:

- All events, including SWPD, SWID and relays (unless indicated), will be swam as 'open' (all together; seeded slowest to fastest based on entry times) mixed gender short course (25m) timed finals.
- Individual events will be resulted into 14 years and under and 15 years and over.
- Relay events will be resulted as open (fastest time swam are the champions).
- No reseeding will be done once the competition program has been published.
- There shall be no disqualifications, however blatant breaking of swimming rules or bad sportsmanship will result in no time being recorded.
- There will be no challenges to the official times.
- Full results will be available on the Event Page

#### **RELAYS**

- All relay team members must have entered, and competed in, at least one individual event.
- Mixed relay teams must consist of at least one male and one female student. Schools may enter mixed and single
  gender relay teams, but a student must not swim both. However, a student can swim two different relays (e.g
  mixed medley and the girls freestyle relay).
- Relay changes, in swimming order (back, breast, fly, free), must be in the Recorder's hands 30 minutes before the start of the competition.

### **WARMUP PROCEDURE**

Warmup commences at 10:15am and concludes at 10:55am with racing starting at 11:00am and is to be supervised by school personnel. Entry into the pool is **feet first entry only** with lanes 2 to 7 used for general swimming, whereas lanes 1 and 8 are the dive and sprint lanes. There are **no warm down lanes available during the competition**.

#### **MARSHALLING**

This competition will be self-marshalled, near the old dive well on the grandstand side of the pool. Students are expected to gather at least 2 heats ahead of their own race, except for 50m events where they need to be prepared 4 heats ahead of their own. It is the responsibility of each individual student and/or Team Manager to ensure they are at the blocks in time to race.

#### **PRIZES**

- Top three (3) students in each age group (14 yrs & under and 15 yrs & over) will be awarded ribbons in each individual event.
- Top three (3) teams will be awarded ribbons in each relay event.
- Ribbons will be posted to schools after the results have been confirmed.

# **RECORDS**

- Otago Secondary School Records will be recognised at this competition.
- Any student breaking a current record will receive a certificate of their achievement.
- Certificates will be posted to school after the results have been confirmed.

#### WITHDRAWAL RULES

- Prior to the commencement of the competition, withdrawals are to be emailed to Swimming Otago.
- During the competition, students wishing to withdraw from an event shall do so in writing, signed by the team manager, and lodged with the recorder.

# **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION**

- The one start rule will apply.
- At the beginning of each race when the whistle is blown, there is to be silence and no movement on poolside.
- Each student is to remain in his/her lane until instructed to leave.
- Students must exit from the side of the pool UNDER the lane ropes.

**Draft documents** will be emailed directly to entered students and schools on Tuesday 24<sup>th</sup> May 2022.

Final documents will be published on the Swimming Otago Event Page on Friday 27<sup>th</sup> May 2022.

**Competition Programme** will be published, and available for printing, from Friday 27<sup>th</sup> May, on the Swimming Otago Event Page. Note there will be NO programs available on the day.

**Results** will be posted on the windows behind the Recorders Office (accessible via the back corridor) and Meet Mobile will be activated.
