The event is ably run by Dunedin Climbing. No experience is needed in abseiling as the event is catered to all levels of expertise. You are in safe hands at all times during the event.

You do not need to be a boss, or be nominated to be tossed. You can volunteer yourself and get others involved. All participants will need their own givealittle page and target for fundraising.

This year, the event is on Friday 12 May between 7.30am and 11am. All participants must be present at 7.30am for the safety briefing. Given we will be inside, there will be no weather cancellation.
