In addition, a second booster is available for all people aged over **50** years

SMOKE ALARMS IN RENTAL PROPERTIES

Most fire fatalities occur in rental properties without working smoke alarms.

LANDLORD or TENANT? WHO IS RESPONSIBLE FOR SMOKE ALARMS? BOTH ARE RESPONSIBLE! Farm owners and contractors are both the landlords.

The <u>LANDLORD</u> is responsible to ensure there are working smoke alarms in every rental, and to replace any smoke alarms that no longer work with new photoelectric ones. All smoke detectors need to be within their <u>expiry dates</u>.

The Landlord is responsible for

- installing compliant smoke alarms in each sleeping space or within 3 metres of each bedroom door; in each level of a multi-level home; in all rental homes, boarding houses, rental caravans, and self-contained sleep-outs.
- Making sure smoke alarms are in working order at the beginning of every new tenancy and remain in working order during the tenancy

It is the <u>TENANTS</u> responsibility to maintain the installed smoke alarm(s), including replacing batteries of the older alarms that have the 9-volt batteries for the duration of their tenancy.

According to www.tenancy.govt.nz Landlords could be fined up to \$7200 and tenants could be fined up to \$4000 for failing to meet these obligations.

Other things to consider:

 don't put a smoke alarm in your kitchen where smoke from cooking could set it off or in your showers or laundry where steam and dust might give false alarms - use a heat alarm in these spaces instead.
