

NZNO Nurses Strike

On Thursday 3rd September 2020 Amuri Health Care's Nursing staff will be on strike.

Most of Amuri Health's nurses are members of the New Zealand Nurses Organisation and are Primary Care Nurses supporting the national strike for the same pay levels as hospital nurses.

This does mean on Thursday there will be no routine nursing services that day and a limited GP service.

A limited District Nursing Service will also be available.

Prescriptions

To avoid running out of your medications, please make sure you check when they are next due and allow at least two weeks prior to that date, so that you have enough time to arrange an appointment to see the doctor and avoid disappointment. All patients must be seen by the doctor every three months for repeat medication. unless otherwise indicated and documented by a doctor in the patients notes.

Occasionally it will be possible to organise a prescription over the telephone, these will incur a \$15 fee and the prescription may take up to 48 hours to be generated, depending on the GPs workload.


