### **Home-Learning Programme**

Home Learning is made up of three components that are self monitored by the students, but will be encouraged and promoted throughout the year in class. The expectation is for all students to complete a minimum of 3 progressions using the MathsWhizz programme, 15 minutes personal reading 4 times a week, and for Year 5's to complete 9 Steeple Rock challenges and Year 6's to complete 10 Steeple Rock challenges throughout the year. Spelling will be part of the daily classroom learning rather than a task assigned for home.

## **Friday Enrichment Programme**

Every Friday afternoon we have an enrichment programme where your child will be part of a small group that spends five weeks learning about visual arts, music, ICT skills, cooking, sewing, library and debating skills. We are very fortunate to have 7 staff running a variety of specialised learning activities, which will begin on Friday 11th February.
