Kia ora Parents/Caregivers,

School Based Immunisation Programme - Commencing March 2023

We are pleased to inform you of changes to the Immunisation Programme for Year 7 and 8 students, to align the immunisation activity to only Year 7 students from 2023.

From 2023 we will offer all Year 7 students both:

- **Boostrix immunisation** (one dose) to provide protection against Tetanus, Diphtheria and Whooping Cough, and
- **HPV immunisation** (two doses 6 months apart) to protect against genital warts, cervical cancer, throat and mouth cancers, and other types of cancers later in life.

In 2023 only we will offer all Year 8 students the:

- **HPV immunisation** (two doses 6 months apart) to protect against genital warts, cervical cancer, throat and mouth cancers, and other types of cancers later in life
 - * Year 7 students were offered their Boostrix immunisation at school this year

This means that from 2024 we will reduce disruption for Year 8 students and minimise the impact on schools. For Year 7 students, the benefits are that they will receive Boostrix earlier in the year - outside of flu/winter season; and students receive their HPV vaccine a year earlier, preparing them for their teenage years.

Please read and complete the enclosed consent form and return it to your child's school as soon as possible.
