Hagley Park is the largest inner-city park in the Southern Hemisphere. It includes a world-class cricket oval, golf course, Botanic Garden, and endless open green spaces enjoyed by locals and visitors alike.

STEP 1 CHOOSE WHAT TO STUDY AND WHERE

Do your research about New Zealand and the Canterbury Region. Decide what you would like to study and find an education provider that offers the qualification. Education agents can assist you and they help with the enrolment process too.

STEP 2 APPLY FOR YOUR COURSE

Contact the education provider you are interested in to start the enrolment process. Complete the required international student enrolment forms and return them to your provider.

STEP 3 APPLY FOR YOUR VISA

Once you have an offer of place or letter of acceptance from your education provider, and you've paid the required fees, apply for your student visa. For full details visit immigration.govt.nz

STEP 4 GET READY TO GO

Once your visa is approved you can make travel arrangements. Inform your education provider about your plans. Plan your stay in Canterbury and make final arrangements for your arrival.
