

Podiatry Clinics

We are pleased to let the community know that there will be a Podiatrist available on Friday afternoons starting September 10th, this will usually be every six weeks. Andrew Hawkey will be seeing patients referred to him via your regular GP, for example those who have chronic conditions such as highrisk diabetes. He will also be able to do general consultations, such as orthotics or nail surgery, for example. If you would like to be referred to see Andrew, or have any questions, please phone, and speak with one of the Practice Nurses.

Booking Appointments

While we try to ensure that we run to time, the doctors and nurses often must deal with emergencies or situations leading urgent unforeseen delays. We appreciate your understanding when this happens, however sometimes the delays are due to booked appointment times that are not long enough to address multiple issues, or perhaps opportunistic consultations for family members, maybe children. If you need additional time for a family member or to discuss multiple issues, please make sure you book appropriately, so as not to impact on another patients' appointment time, which results in the GP running late. 


