Culverden Ambulance Operations Report February-March 2023

This is the first one of regular reports of the operations carried out by the Culverden Ambulance (Hurunui1) and the Hanmer Springs First Response Unit.

February and March have been quite busy, particularly February in Hanmer Springs. Since 1st February to 18th March Culverden and Hanmer Ambulance officers responded to 74 incidents in our area of which 44 were transported to the most appropriate treatment centre.

Pertussis (Whooping Cough)

Pertussis (Whooping Cough)
There have been 3 deaths nationwide from Pertussis (Whooping Cough).

As a practice ACHC recommends that pregnant mothers are immunised for this and can be from 16 weeks into your pregnancy.

It is also very important to ensure all childhood vaccinations are up to date. Children older than 7 years and not fully immunised can receive 'Boostrix' a vaccine given as part of the catchup programme.

This is also available to purchase for those that do not qualify for the funded vaccine. Please telephone Amuri Health on 03 315 6328 to make an appointment or request to speak with the practice nurse to discuss further.

This well-presented farm is very productive, with most paddocks described in S-maps as being predominantly Mairaki moderately deep silt over clay, with some areas of Waipara moderately deep silt over clay. There is an area of Eyre stony silt loam along the east of the road, below the terrace. This gives an excellent balance, enabling stock to be moved to the lighter soil when it is very wet. Considered "summer safe", the property has an average rainfall of 1000mm. The property has very good infrastructure, with good cattle-yards, sheep-yards and covered yards/woolshed complex. The woolshed is a 3-stand raised board layout with a good size wool room and the covered yards can be set up for drenching and drafting or using the pneumatic sheep handler. With 2 haysheds on each side of the road, the distance from paddock to shed is kept to a minimum for carting and feeding out.


