The Year 11 results were outstanding. 103/173 students achieved marks of 80% or more, well above our previous best results.

The Year 12 and 13 results were well above our 2011-2020 average.

Aimee Wang in Year 13 gained our best mark ever in A levels. She achieved 75/75 in the Pure Mathematics paper and 50/50 in the Statistics paper.
