#### APPLICATIONS FOR FUNDING FOR NATIVE PLANTING

The Hurunui District Landcare Group (HDLG) is excited to announce it is opening up applications for the second round of funding for native planting. The HDLGs Catchment Planting programme will fund the planting of 65 hectares of native forest restoration and 17 kilometres of native riparian planting. The first round of funding applications were opened up in October last year and saw all of the riparian planting fully allocated. We are now looking for applications for funding to plant a native area. We have 33 hectares of native plant funding available and welcome HDLG members to apply for funding by filling out an application form. Applications forms are available by contacting admin@hurunuilandcaregroup.co.nz or by contacting your local Catchment Farm Advisor (details below).

Applications close 5pm on Friday the 11<sup>th</sup> of June 2021. No late applications will be considered.

If you are not sure whether your planting site would be suitable or have any questions regarding the funding please get in contact with your local Catchment Farm Advisor. Successful applicants will be notified by mid-August 2021. #### **Flu Vaccines**

Flu season is upon us and flu vaccines are available now. Please ring reception to arrange an appointment.

Vaccines are free if:

- You are 65 years and over
- You are pregnant
- You have a chronic health condition.

All **non-funded** vaccines cost **\$25** for registered adults and children or **\$36** for non-enrolled patients.

Please also be aware that you are required to have a two-week gap before or after your flu vaccination before you can get your covid vaccine as per Ministry of Health vaccination guidelines.

Amuri Health will be offering covid vaccines on site and this is not likely to start before July.

## Registering at the Health Centre

If you reside within our community or would like Amuri Health Centre to be your main point of health care, we encourage you to enrol with us. You will receive subsidised health care, be eligible for funded services and receive seamless care by doing so.

As per Ministry of Health guidelines patients may only enrol at one Health Centre.

Although we can provide care to patients who are not enrolled with us, their visits will incur increased fees as we do not receive any funding to subsidise these.

If you are a non-New Zealander on a work visa, you may still be able to enrol. Please contact reception to check if you are eligible.




