What You Need to Know

- There will be cones and construction vehicles whilst work is being carried out. On-street parking may be **unavailable** in the construction areas.
- You will still have access to your property during the work period. However, Traffic Management will be used to manage this access and the speed of vehicles driving through the work site.
- Please let us know if you have any specific requirements for property access i.e. for medical visits, home help, large vehicle deliveries/moving, or other planned work on your property.
- Residue from new surfaces, like asphalt and chipseal, can stick to your shoes or car tyres after the first few days of works being completed. Please be mindful of this when entering your garage or home. Please also be assured that we have been working with contractors to source new products that limit the chances of this occurring, and have already been trialling them across the wider Christchurch area.
- Surfaces may be uneven at times, we will aim to minimise this.
- Work will be rescheduled if the weather is bad.
- There may be periods of noise and vibration, although we will aim to keep this to a minimum.
- We will complete the work as quickly as possible, your patience will be appreciated.
