
Robin in da Hood

Dear Parents & Whanau.

Our students from Omokoroa No1 School have been working tirelessly to produce a spectacle not to be missed, 'Robin in da Hood'. It is remarkable to witness their level of progress since the start of Term 4. We know you will be utterly Gobsmacked with what they have in store for you!

In **show week (23 – 25 November, 2020)** we have a very busy and important timetable. We ask that you take note of the schedule overleaf and support us with ensuring your child is at **EVERY** rehearsal and show. Please notify us immediately if for some urgent reason your child will not be able to attend, as we will need to re-arrange their class item.



Hairspray and makeup will be provided for students on show nights and the matinee, however parents are welcome to apply stage makeup to their child/ren and put girls hair put in a bun, before they arrive at school on Tuesday and Wednesday mornings and before 6pm at Bethlehem College, as it would speed up the process.

Make-up:

BOYS: foundation, eyeliner, brown eyeshadow, blush and lipstick.

GIRLS: foundation, eyeliner, mascara, red/pink blush & lipstick). ALL girls must have their hair in a neat bun. If you are not able to put on make-up or do hair we will do it at Bethlehem College.

It is important ALL students are dropped off at Omokoroa No1 School before 8:45am on Monday, Tuesday & Wednesday.

On Tuesday 24th November, please drop your child/children to Bethlehem College Performing Arts Centre, at <u>6pm</u>. The foyer will be open at 6pm for guests to buy raffle tickets and programmes. Parents will not be able to go backstage with their children.

Professional Production costs

- Students asked to contribute \$4.00 per week, a total of \$20.00 for this experience, per student.
- Buses will transport students to and from the Bethlehem Performing Arts Centre for rehearsals and matinee on the 23, 24 and 25 of November. A few reminders for Show Week:

- Tickets are selling really well remember to order your tickets asap.
- Remember tickets are available for families, friends and the wider community so spread the word! No limit of sales per family.
- Students will need morning tea, lunch and a water bottle for the 3 days at Bethlehem College.
- On Wednesday children need to have a substantial packed afternoon tea/early dinner to give them plenty of energy for the last show.
- All students will stay at Bethlehem College at the conclusion of the matinee on Wednesday to prepare for the last evening show.
- Costumes Most costume items for the musical are provided by Gobsmacked. However, we advise that ALL girls wear a shoestring black singlet and black bike pants underneath their costume so that everyone can get changed without a changing room. Boys are welcome to wear a singlet and little black shorts/briefs if they feel self-conscious about getting changed too in front of everyone. The Pretend Ghosts need to bring a white singlet (white shorts will be provided for them).
