





WAIAU BRIDGE CLOSURES

The temporary Bailey Bridge was successfully removed, and we are now onto the last construction phase on the Waiau Bridge. We're on track for this to be complete by early September. This work will require some day and night closures. Due to upcoming closures on SH1 for the installation of a rockfall canopy, we are restricted in the dates we can close the Waiau Bridge. We'd like to thank you for your patience while we complete this essential work.



What will we be doing?

On Monday 17 August we will be prepping the road for sealing and lowering the bridge. On Tuesday 18 August, we'll complete the road sealing.

During a night closure on Friday 28 August, we will be installing the final rubber expansion joints. These are custom flexible joints that allow the bridge decks to move. This is the last major repair to be completed on the bridge.

How will this impact me?

Day Closures:

- Monday 17 Augustmidday to 2pm
- Tuesday 18 August
 midday to 2pm

Emergency vehicles will still have access.

Night Closures:

- Friday 28 August, from 8pm, until 8am Saturday 29 August.
- Note the night of Saturday 29 is our contingency date if required.

There will be restricted access for emergency vehicles.

Please note all closures are weather dependent.

Detour

Detour arrows will be set up to divert traffic, via River Road, continuing along Leslie Hills Road onto Mouse Point Road (SH7). This adds an extra 20 – 30 minutes to your journey.
