Moving to a new country can be difficult enough for anyone, but for people arriving as refugees it may pose an even greater challenge. We offer extensive training to equip volunteers with the resources they will need to support people arriving in the Wellington region.

Many former refugees arrive with few belongings and will be resettling. Refugee support Volunteers are invaluable because they provide support for day-to-day tasks that may be challenging for new arrivals. We often hear of volunteers who have become like 'family' to those they are helping to resettle.
