#### Kids Fest 2020 at the Waimakariri Libraries



Entertain your kids over the winter school holidays with Kids Fest. With hundreds of cool events and activities, there is plenty of fun stuff to keep the kids amused. Kids Fest is an annual two-week festival designed especially for children age 0-13, and has entertained thousands of children and families over the past 26 years. Running since 1992, with events in Christchurch, Banks Peninsula, Waimakariri, and Selwyn Districts, Kids Fest is excited to be back in 2020!

The Waimakariri Libraries are hosting events in Oxford, Rangiora, and Kaiapoi. The libraries are bringing back some of their popular events such as the perennial favourite: Mystery Trails, where kids can come along to the libraries and use clues to find the hidden pirates in the shelves; and the famous Family Quiz Nights are also returning – perhaps your family can take out the number one spot this year?

New activities this year include daytime, and evening activities to give kids the chance to get creative in the school holidays. Children and their families will have an opportunity to get in touch with nature at crafting sessions, where families can design their own nature collage, or try their hand at designing their own pet rock!

Also new this year is a Karate Safety Awareness Workshop at the Kaiapoi Library, designed to introduce children to the principles of safety awareness – from awareness of their surroundings, simple things they can do to keep themselves safe, and up to the last resort of self-defence.

Young Writers will have four opportunities to work with real writers as tutors, to engage and excite young people in the writing process. The School for Young Writers has been inspiring young writers for 25 years, and their tutors are all practising writers and skilled teachers. These Workshops are designed for Year 5-8 young writers.

The majority of the libraries' Kids Fest events are free, except for one key event with Sport Suzie, New Zealand's Crazy Aerobics, Sport and Circus fanatic. Inspired by the great Jane Fonda, Flashdance, and the music of the eighties, Suzie aims to shake the laughter out of any audience. Tickets are available at all Waimakariri Libraries, for the shows at the Rangiora Town Hall, and Oxford Town Hall, \$5 per ticket.
