Winter Road Safety Tips

Are you visible on the road to other drivers?

Lights on during the darker mornings, evenings and when it is foggy, or raining. **Drive to the conditions and Be Seen!**

SMOKE ALARMS

- Check smoke alarms are working/replace battery if required
- Inspect smoke alarm for expiry date
- Keep alarms dust & spider free

Landlords and Farm Owners please ensure all your houses have working smoke alarms.

Home Fire Safety Tips Once a fire starts, it spreads very quickly!

- Clean your stove top after every use as spilled fat build up can easily catch fire.
- Keep looking while you're cooking! Never leave cooking unattended.
- Never throw water onto a fry pan that is on fire. Instead place the fry pan lid or a chopping board on the pan to starve the fire of oxygen.
- Heater metre rule: keep flammables at least 1m away from any heat sources.
- Replace your electric blanket every 5 years. Worn and old electric blankets can cause an electric shock and fire.
- Never sleep with an electric blanket turned on, even on low temperatures.
- **LPG gas heaters:** if they don't light straight away, turn it off and then try again. Don't allow the gas to build up before trying to relight.
- **Laundry:** empty the clothes dryer filter after every use to reduce fire risk. Ensure there is proper ventilation and air space around the dryer.
