Wellness Checks

Are you due for your Annual Wellness Check or never had one?

These are completed over two visits and on the first visit blood tests are done with the practice nurse and a consultation with the doctor. You will have a follow up visit with the doctor to discuss results.

The first GP & PN visits are for 45 minutes and the second GP visit is for 15 minutes with one fee to cover both.

If you would like to make an appointment, please phone reception to arrange a time. This is a great value service all for \$120 for our enrolled population, an additional charge applies for non-enrolled patients.

Level 2 Update from Amuri Community Health

As you will all be aware the country has returned to different levels of operation during the ongoing global Covid -19 Pandemic.



From 15th February 2021 Amuri Health will operate under Level 2 protocols. Appointments will be available both by telephone and face to face, as necessary. These will continue to be charged at the same rate.

The doors will be open, and we ask that everyone please ring for an appointment before arriving to ensure adequate triage and contact tracing can be undertaken. Screening questions as to your current symptoms and symptom history will continue to be asked. Your honesty and openness are paramount when answering our triage questions to ensure everyone's safety.

We have created social distancing in the waiting room, and this will need to be adhered to. There is dedicated seating for you to use. We respectfully ask, that where possible, additional family members that are not needed for your consultation are not with you at the time of your appointment. This is to try to minimise the number and contacts of patients within the practice.

We continue to ask that patients sign in using the QR codes at the Health Centre entrance and or waiting room or sign the register at the front desk. Please routinely hand sanitise and maintain social distancing. If you wish to use a facemask, please ask reception and they can provide one for you.

If you are early for your appointment, please wait in your car until your appointment time to help avoid congestion within the practice.

If you have made an appointment due to being unwell, or have been identified as being at risk, you will be asked to enter the building from the back ambulance bay park, again please let us know when you arrive and wait in your car until your clinician is ready to see you.

We continue to offer paywave for your convenience and where possible encourage you to use this option for paying your account. Please stand back behind the line at the reception until the receptionist has entered the required details and asks you to step forward for your payment. The eftpos machine will be sanitised after each transaction.

Covid-19 testing will continue to be undertaken for those with respiratory symptoms and it is also vital for those with symptoms (Cough/Runny nose/Sore throat/loss of smell) to be checked.

We thank you for your patience and understanding as we return to Level 2, operating under strict guidelines to ensure safety and health in our community.
