Please take time to read the following information. Failure to comply may mean we will ask for your key to be returned with no refund.

The Diamond Harbour School swimming pool will be available to key holders and their dependents during the following hours:

11:00am to 8:00pm Monday to Sunday during school holidays. CLOSED 24th, 25th, 26th DECEMBER 2018 and 1st JANUARY 2019.

DURING TERM TIME 4:30PM TO 8:00PM WEEKDAYS. 11.00am TO 8.00pm WEEKENDS.

CONDITIONS OF USE

- 1. Please ensure the GATE IS LOCKED AT ALL TIMES and MUST NOT BE TIED OPEN AT ANY TIME FOR ANY REASON.
- 2. PLEASE USE THE OUTDOOR SHOWER LOCATED BY THE PUMP SHED BEFORE ENTERING THE POOL. This helps to maintain water quality.
- 3. When the cover is on, this means the pool is closed Do not try to swim with the cover on as there is a risk of drowning.
- 4. No glass, food, alcohol, smoking or animals permitted inside the pool complex. Please no boats, surfboards or other large floatation devices.
- 5. Our school is a litter free environment. Please take any rubbish home.
- 6. Long hair is to be tied up or swim caps worn.
- 7. No diving or jumping off the pool cover or sides of the pool. We want to protect our cover.
- 8. Walking inside the pool area is recommended.
- 9. Children in nappies or who are not toilet trained are not permitted to use the pool unless proper **swimming nappies** are worn.
- 11. Outside toilet at the end of Te Kete Aronui is available for use. The key is issued with the pool key. Please encourage your children to use it.
- 12. DUE TO STRINGENT TESTING REQUIREMENTS THE POOL MAY BE CLOSED AT ANY TIME WITHOUT NOTICE. Check the school website (www.diamondharbourschool.co.nz) or SchoolApp alerts for status updates.
- 13. All using the pool must comply with requests made by the caretaker. If he requests that you leave the pool, this must be done immediately.
- 14. All swimming out of school hours is at the swimmer's risk.
- 15. Only <u>adults</u> (persons aged 18 years and older) may be key holders. They must personally supervise their dependents within the pool complex and take total responsibility for their behaviour, safety and enforcement of pool rules. children must be actively supervised.
- 16. Keys are not transferable. Please respect this. The money collected from the hire of pool keys covers a portion of our running costs.

SWIMMING POOL HEALTH PROCEDURES

- 1. If a child or adult has had diarrhoea (tummy bug) in the last two weeks she/he is not to enter the pool.
- 3. If children have impetigo (school sores) they are not to enter the pool.
- 4. Children / adults with infectious disease (refer Infectious Diseases Chart) are prohibited from using the pool.
