

We're resurfacing your street

Titahi Bay / Semple RAB

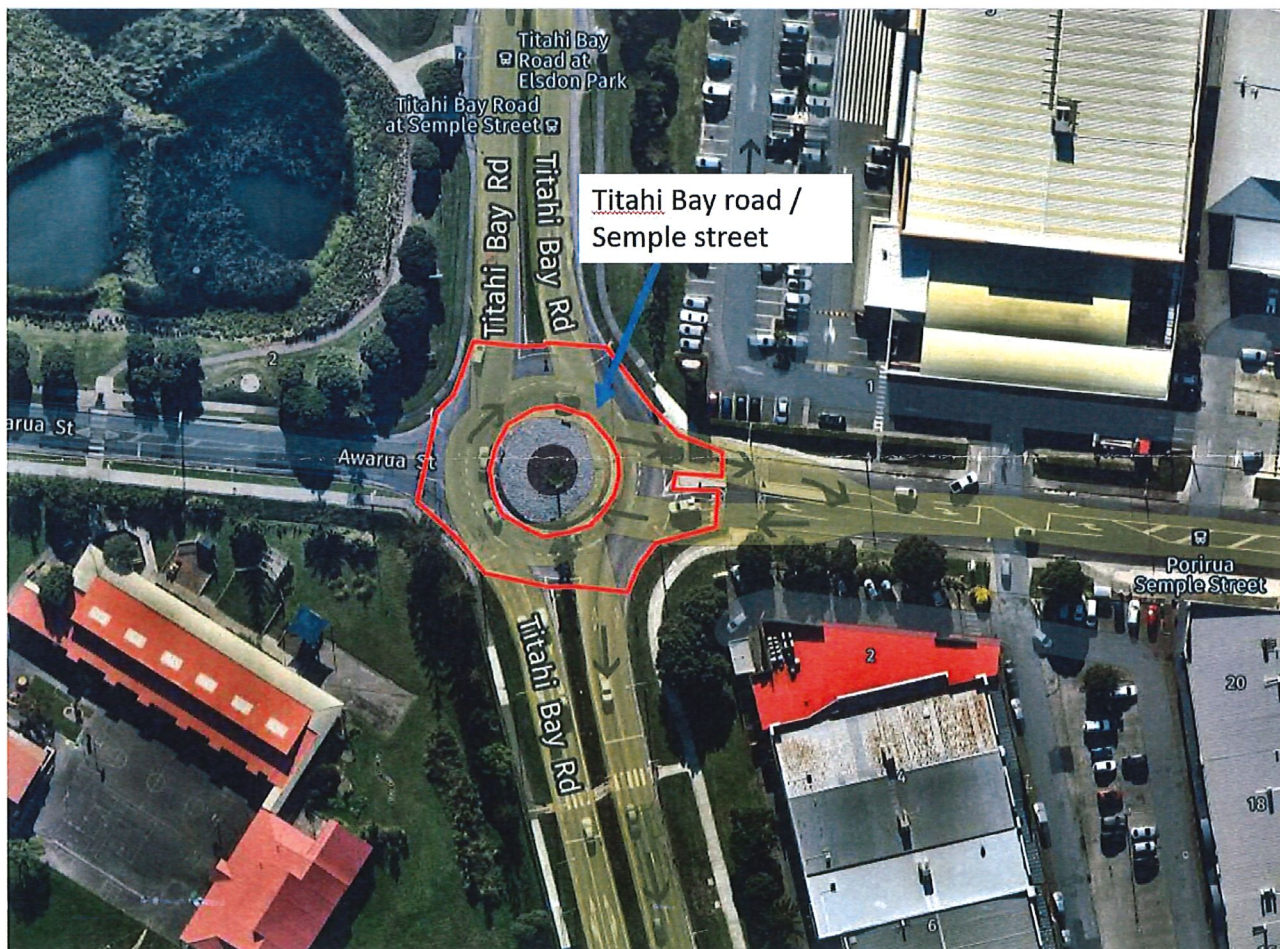
Planned work: Road resurfacing with asphalt.

Location: Titahi Bay / Semple Round RAB. See site map below.

Please note traffic management will be in place and surrounding streets may be set-up for traffic management or have parked machinery/work vehicles involved in this work.

When: From Sunday 24 September 2023 to Wednesday 27 September 2023, between **6:30pm and 5:30am**.

Important note: Please keep the resurfacing site clear of parked vehicles during the resurfacing works and road remarking. *See back page for details.*



Weather: For best results we only carry out this work in favourable weather. If the weather is unsuitable, it will be done on the next suitable fine day.

Delays: If the work is delayed for a period of three (3) days or longer we will provide notice of the new intended start date.

Resurfacing - what you need to know:

Vehicles: We need the road clear of all vehicles to carry out this work. Residents are therefore requested to please park elsewhere for this period. If a vehicle is left on the road during these times, it will be relocated, with due care, by a towing company. Where possible it will be relocated to a nearby street.

Return Visits: Where possible we return in 48 hours following the resurfacing works to reinstate road markings and to raise the service covers. Please keep the road clear of vehicles during this time. If a vehicle is left on the road during these times, it will be relocated, with due care, by a towing company. Where possible it will be relocated to a nearby street.

Bitumen: The material used to resurface your street contains bitumen. Bitumen is a sticky black substance that is used throughout the country for road resurfacing works. To avoid tracking materials inside, please try to avoid recently sealed surfaces. If you must walk on it, please check your shoes before going inside or getting into vehicles. For advice on the removal of bitumen from surfaces please call the contractor listed below.

Safety: Please stand well back from the action and follow all instructions from the work crew onsite. Children have a fascination with roadworks, and we ask that you warn them of the dangers. Please also keep pets inside during the works. If you do need to cross the site, please liaise with crew on site first and avoid any hazards.

Disruption: We understand roadworks can be disruptive and will endeavour to minimise the impact on you, your family and/or your business. We appreciate your co-operation and patience.
