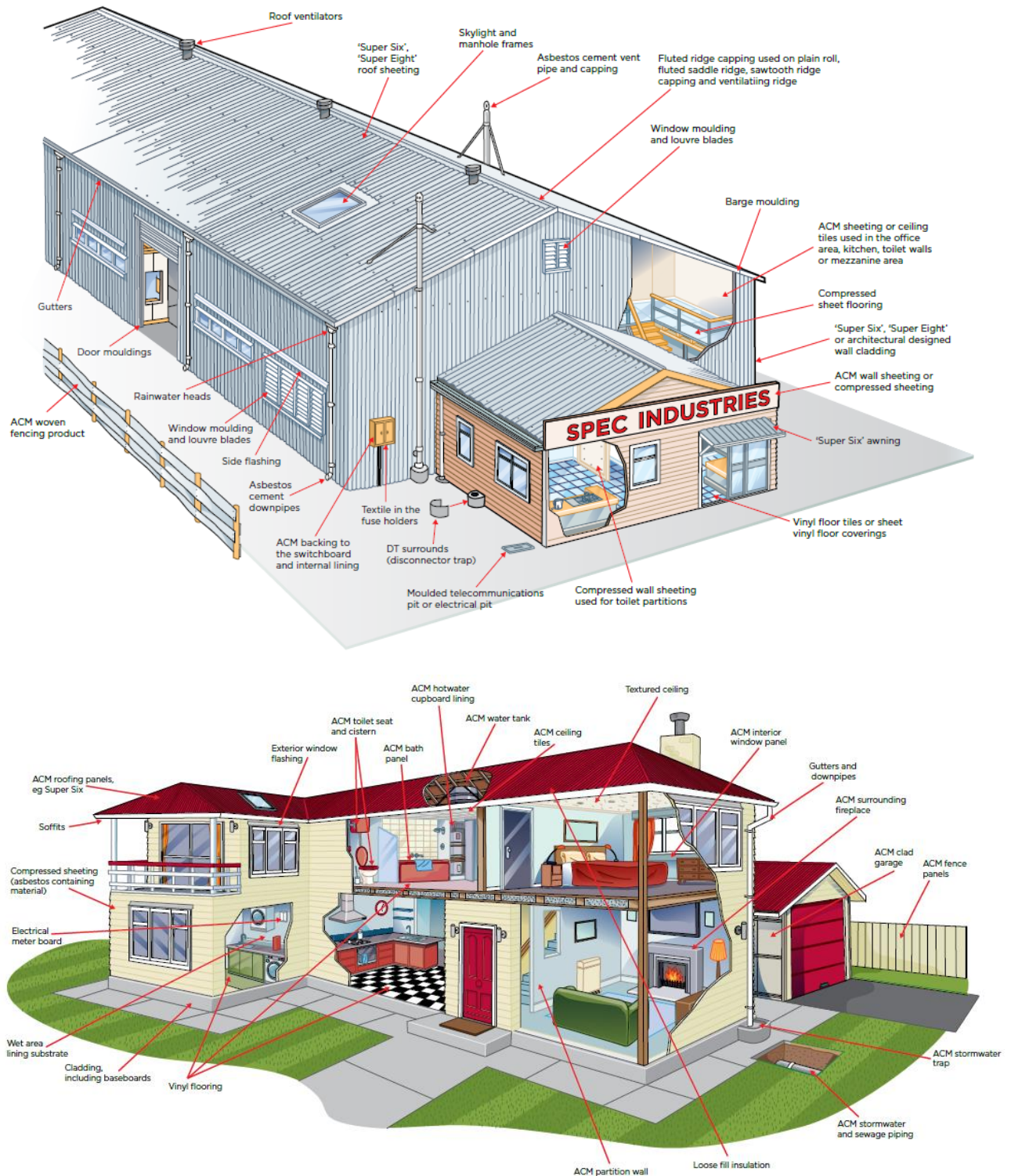


Asbestos Management

Asbestos is tricky, it's hidden, and except for some well known asbestos containing products like Super Six or Super Eight roof sheeting, you need a microscope to identify it.

Things to consider in our Church settings

Only use qualified asbestos surveyors.

Only use licenced asbestos contractors for work involving asbestos.

Confirm the asbestos status of your building/s before undertaking ANY work (regardless of the amount of work).

Notify WorkSafe of Major Incidents WorkSafe 0800 030 040

Asbestos contamination is a notifiable incident.
