Church Services and the Traffic Light system:

As with every community-facing group, the Amuri Cooperating Parish (ACP) has had to rethink how to organise worship services in the light of mandatory vaccination for church ministers and changing rules around community gatherings.

While COVID has minimal presence in Canterbury, we will continue using best health practices by, signing in with the QR code, recommending the use of masks during services, observing social distancing apart from people in your bubble, and staying away if feeling unwell. After the Government's announcements on December 3rd, the Parish Council has chosen to operate in a similar way, without requiring evidence of vaccination passes. We anticipate that this will be the case for worship on December 5^{th,} but we will evaluate week by week for subsequent services.

Once COVID is uncontained in Canterbury, we will still gather to worship and pray but only at St Mary's, Rotherham. Our seating arrangements will change and, when possible, we will gather outside. Please note that the Carol Service will be outside.

If COVID becomes uncontained in Amuri, we will make use of technology and on-line worship again for a time. However it seems this virus is here to stay in one form or other and so we will aim to live our lives as normally as possible but take as many precautions as we can to keep everyone safe.
