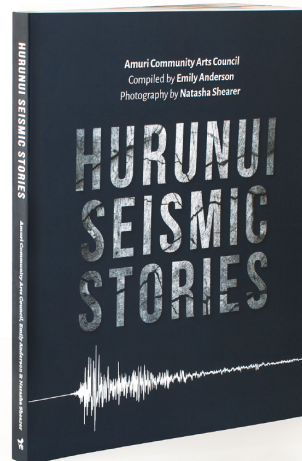

Vaccines are **free** if:

- **You are 65 years and over**
- **You are pregnant**
- **You have a chronic health condition.**

All **non-funded** vaccines cost **\$25** for registered adults and children or **\$36** for non-enrolled patients.

Please also be aware that you are required to have a two-week gap before or after your flu vaccination before you can get your covid vaccine as per Ministry of Health vaccination guidelines.

Amuri Health will be offering covid vaccines and will advertise when these will start.

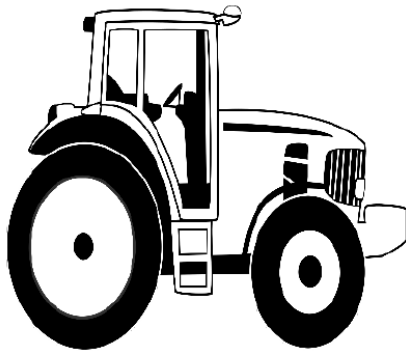
