- 4. Decisions on applications for awards will be made by the Wanaka Musicians Society, who will seek advice as necessary from the Head of Music at Mount Aspiring College.
- 5. All applications received by 5 pm on Friday 17 March 2023 will be considered; thereafter, any funds remaining may be disbursed on an ad hoc basis.
