Procedure Plan for Alert Level 2 -what school will look like at Alert Level 2?

The following information is aligned with the Ministries of Health & Education guidelines for schools. Please take the time to read through carefully, and to discuss with your child.



WELLBEING

- Students and staff need to stay home if they are unwell.
- Anyone who becomes unwell with symptoms of Covid 19 during the school day will be sent home

PARENTS IN SCHOOL

- Parents are highly encouraged to drop their kids off, in the drop off zone or for children to bike, walk or scooter to school.
- Please only enter the school if you really have to. You will need to be recorded on our Contact Tracing registers. Pūkeko will have their own register. All other parents need to head to the office before coming in to school.
- Parents will not be able to stay for whānau time at the start or end of each day, and visits to school should be kept as short as possible please.




- Kāhu and Tūī students leave at 2.30pm.

LEARNING

CLEANING AND HYGIENE

- Drinking fountains will be turned off.
- Please ensure your child has a personal water bottle.
- Cleaners will complete daily cleans in line with the Ministry of Health guidelines

PHYSICAL DISTANCING

• At Alert Level 2 the bubble system is not required. Students and staff will still avoid physical contact as much as possible and keep personal space. The students will be free to move around the school.



ATTENDANCE
