## NGUTUAWA SCHOOL (3288) Commences on 01 January 2022

## **Home Zone**

All students who live within the home zone described below shall be eligible to enrol at the school.

Starting from the intersection of Dyers Road (SH74) and Linwood Avenue

- South East along the southern side of Linwood Avenue to Charlesworth Reserve
- South West through Charlesworth Reserve to Charlesworth Street
- South West along Charlesworth Street to Ferry Road
  - Including Olds Place
- North West along Ferry Road to Tunnel Road (SH74)
  - Including Ferry Road between Charlesworth Street and Waterman Place (including address #950 Ferry Road)
- South along Tunnel Road (SH74) to Port Hills Road (SH76)
- West along the northern side only of Port Hills Road (SH76) to Chapmans Road
- North along the eastern side of Chapmans Road to the Opawaho / Heathcote River
- West along the north bank of the Opawaho / Heathcote River to a point adjacent to the Chichester Street / Cumnor Terrace intersection
- North along the east side only of Cumnor Terrace to Sheldon Street
- North along (both sides of) Cumnor Terrace to Laura Kent Place
- From the Cumnor Terrace / Laura Kent Place intersection, North East across the river to 11
  Heathcote Street
- North East along Heathcote Street to Ferry Road
- South East along Ferry Road to Portman Street
- North East along Portman Street to Glenroy Street
  - o Including all addresses on Portman Street and Charlotte Lane
- South East along Glenroy Street to St Johns Street
- North East along St Johns Street to Linwood Avenue
  - Including Stacey Place,
  - o Including Clydesdale St, Dunoon PI, Claymore St, Cob Cres, Shetland St, and Lomond PI
- South East on Linwood Avenue to Dyers Road (SH74)
  - Including addresses accessed from, or located on the south side of Linwood Avenue between St Johns Street and Hargood Street

Addresses on both sides of boundary roads are considered in-zone unless specified otherwise.

Each year, applications for enrolment in the following year from in-zone students will be sought by a date that will be published by public notice in a medium appropriate to the area served by the school. This will enable the board to assess the number of places that can be made available to students who live outside the home zone.

## **Special Programmes**

This priority category is not applicable at this school because the school does not run a Special programme approved by the Secretary.

## **Out of Zone Enrolments**

Applications for enrolments will be processed in the following order of priority:

- 1. **First priority** is not applicable at this school because the school does not run a special programme approved by the Secretary for Education.
- 2. **Second priority** must be given to any applicant who is the sibling of a current student of the school.
- 3. **Third priority** must be given to any student who is the sibling of a former student of the school.
- 4. **Fourth priority** must be given to any applicant who is the child of a former student of the school.
- 5. **Fifth priority** must be given to any applicant who is a child of an employee of the school's board or a child of a member of the school's board.
- 6. **Sixth priority** must be given to all other applicants.

Before the application deadline associated with each pre-enrolment period, a Board must, by public notice in a medium appropriate to the area served by the school:

- confirm the already advertised dates for the receipt of applications and for the holding of the ballot
- state the likely number of out of zone places that remain available.

If there are more applicants in any priority group than there are places available, selection within the priority group will be by ballot conducted in accordance with <u>instructions by the Secretary</u>, under <u>Schedule 20, Clause 3 (1)</u> of the Education and Training Act 2020. Parents will be informed of the date of any ballot by public notice in a medium appropriate to the area served by the school.

Applicants may be required to give proof of address or sibling relationship.

The guidelines for development and operation of enrolment schemes are issued under Schedule 20, Clause 3 (3) of the Education and Training Act 2020 for the purpose of describing the basis on which the Secretary's powers in relation to enrolment schemes will be exercised.
