Course	- One course hour is equal to approximately 55 minutes of tuition - Regular full-time schedule = 26 hours/week. This consists of 23 hours normal class time plus 3 hours or more of optional study, including pronunciation class, conversation class, Job Hunter, Coffee Club, and teacher-guided self-study in our Self Access Learning Centre 'The Learning Hub'. Optional classes are available to full-time and part-time students.
Fees	- Fees apply to all enrolments received after 1 January 2020 - Accommodation rates effective for all accommodation from 1 January 2020, irrespective of enrolment date - All fees include NZ Goods and Services Tax (GST) of 15% - The Campbell Institute/UP Education reserve the right to amend prices of any courses and programmes at any time - For Withdrawal and Refund regulations, please refer to www.campbell.ac.nz - The New Zealand Government has imposed an international student levy on tuition fees.
