CONDITIONS OF ENTRY: This competition is open to everyone except competition judge(s) and their immediate family.

Please take care to enter your image in the correct class.

The exposure of the image must be the original work of the entrant.

Prints may be trade processed and may be digitally enhanced.

No watermarks on photos allowed

A maximum of five (5) entries per category is allowed.

Entries are to be 6" x 4" NOT MOUNTED.

No entry that has previously won a prize at the Nelson A & P Show is eligible for entry.

An image may be entered once only in either Adults, Children's or Horticultural sections, not multiple.

Please deliver entries, entry forms to the Nelson A & P office at the Richmond Showgrounds.

Photos must be unframed; i.e. no glass: Class and title, name, address, phone number, corresponding to the entry form must be printed clearly on the back of photo, top centre. All exhibits are to be packed securely and marked "Photography Section".

Old, marked or dirty images will not be accepted.

Entries that do not meet these conditions will be disqualified.

Exhibits and prizes can be collected after 3.30pm on the Sunday or from the A & P office during the week after the show..

Exhibitors requiring their entries to be returned by mail or courier must include return postage or courier tickets/bags with their entries.

The utmost care will be taken by the organisers but the A & P Association do not accept any responsibility for damage to exhibits while in their possession

Please note: "Portrait" is a photo where a person or an animal is the focus of the photo (usually close up), not the orientation of the photo.

"Landscape " is a photo of a landscape, not the orientation of the photo.
