CHANEYS ON-RAMP TO ONE LANE DIVERSION

To construct the Christchurch Northern Corridor so it can tie into the existing Northern Motorway we have to temporarily divert traffic using the Chaney's on-ramp.

The current two lanes on Chaney's on-ramp will be closed, the new diversion road next to it provides for one lane of traffic. Please be aware of the changed traffic condition and take care.

Traffic Impact

The current Chaney's on-ramp will be closed to all traffic from **Tuesday 30 May**.

Drivers will be able to use the Chaney's on-ramp diversion road to access the motorway (SH1).

You may encounter congestion at peak times as the temporary diversion road allows for only one lane of traffic.

We apologise for the inconvenience and thank you for your patience.

The map on the back of this flyer shows the location of the Chaney's on-ramp (blue line on the map).

Future connectivity

The Chaney's on-ramp in 2020 will be removed, meaning there will be no access at this point onto the motorway. Access onto the motorway will be further west at the existing Main North Road/Dickey's Road intersection.

When the new motorway is finished traffic from the north going into town will veer left of the existing Northern Motorway to enter the CNC. Traffic on the Christchurch Northern Corridor going north will travel under the existing Chaney's Bridge and merge onto the Northern Motorway SH1. Bridges will take the Christchurch Northern Corridor over Main North Road and the railway line.

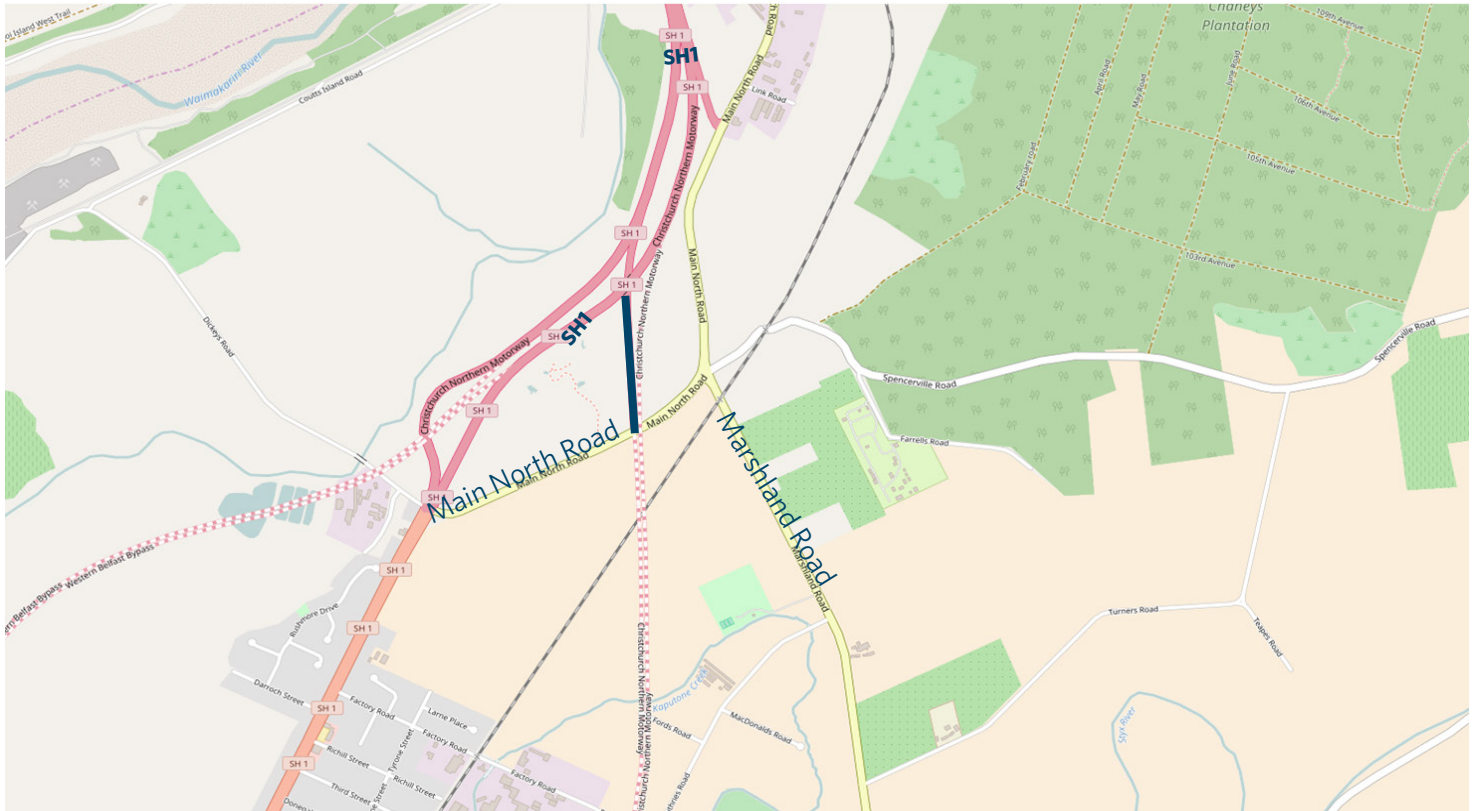
