



YEAR 4 MUSEUM SLEEPOVER - 2018

DATES	Thursday 16 - Friday 17 August = Room 7 and Room 3 Thursday 23 - Friday 24 August = Room 8 and Room 4
TIME	Children leave school at 2.30pm on Thursday to be at the museum for afternoon tea at 3pm. They will return to school on Friday at about 2.45pm. The children can wear mufti to school on Thursday. Parents who are coming to the museum please meet in the Hub at 2:30pm.
COST	Children: \$57 Parents: \$23.00 - Museum costs (plus an additional \$10 for parents to attend the planetarium - this is optional) All payments are due by Friday 10 August
FOOD	All food is provided – pizza, bread and fruit for tea, cereal and fruit for breakfast. Any special dietary requirements need to be advised. On Friday children will be provided with morning tea and all children will have Subway at Moana Pool, cost included. <u>Parents will need to buy their own lunch on the Friday.</u>
SLEEPING	Children and adults sleep in the museum. A bed roll is provided for each child. Children and adults need their own sleeping bag and pillow. Parents are welcome to bring their own bed roll or stretcher.
CLOTHING	Suitable clothing for inside the museum with soft shoes, pyjamas, toilet bag, soft toy (one). Please note: it can be very warm inside the museum at night, so light clothing for sleeping is recommended. Children <u>may not</u> bring cell phones or electronic devices e.g. iPads, tablets etc. Children <u>must</u> carry their own luggage upstairs.
AFTER HOURS	There is limited access between 5pm and 8.30 am. Please let us know if this may cause any problems.
MEDICATION	Please ensure children hand essential medication to the teacher.
BEHAVIOUR	It is important that children understand that only the best behaviour at all times will be acceptable.
FRIDAY'S PROGRAMME:	We will be going to the Edgar Sports Centre after leaving the Museum at 9:30 am, to take part in indoor games. From there we will head to Moana Pool. We will have lunch at 12.00, after which we will swim and hydro slide until our return to school. We will require parents to swim with the children for safety reasons. Parents are welcome to take their children home once passengers have been dropped off.
MUSEUM POLICY	No Alcohol. Please be aware that parent helpers are required to remain with children at all times.
PARKING	Please be aware that parking around the museum is Pay and Display and this cost will need to be covered by you.
