

Minecraft for Education



Dear parents,

Minecraft for Education is used at Waimea Intermediate School in a Friday module, later in the year. Students who have an account can also use it at lunchtimes in the ICT suite (limited to one lunchtime booking each week). If your child would like a school 'Minecraft for Education' account, they need to return this permission form, with a payment of \$3 to the library desk.

Minecraft for Education is a lot like interactive, online lego. It is similar to Minecraft; however it exists in a sandbox environment, so students are only able to interact with other students from our school who also have Waimea Intermediate Minecraft for Education accounts.

In module classes, students will be mostly designing and building to complete challenges. In lunchtime sessions, students can play in either creative or survival modes. We encourage them to use their RISE (respect, integrity, self management and empathy) values and only join games with friends who enjoy a similar style of play to themselves.

Students who have a school account can download Minecraft for Education onto a home computer and play from home if they wish. The login created for each child is valid until the end of the 2018 school year.
