### Mathematics in Year 12

If a student does not have numeracy by the end of Year 11 they take 11MAN in year 12.

They would be on an IEP and would only need to be in 11MAN until they got there numeracy.

Your current Mathematics teacher will advise you which Mathematics course would best suit you.

### **NCEA Level 2 Requirements**

#### 80 credits

- Minimum of 60 credits from Level 2 or above
- 20 are carried forward from Level 1
- including 5 reading credits and 5 writing credits to meet the University Entrance requirement. These credits can be gained from standards from a number of subjects.
  - It is recommended that students aim for the highest possible achievement rather than just gaining credits.
