

Spring Reminders

- Birds are busy looking for nest building spots. Please check tractors, farm machinery & vehicles before use. Birds can build a nest in the short time it takes you to eat your lunch.
- Outdoor burns check weather conditions prior to lighting.
 Avoid burning if we are expecting strong winds.
- Windy conditions avoid travelling on the roads if possible. If you have to travel drive with caution as there is likely to be debris around.

SMOKE ALARMS SAVE LIVES

Daylight saving managed to sneak up on us last weekend! However, it's not too late to

- Check your smoke alarms are working
- If your smoke alarm has a 9V battery, replace the battery every year or change them to the long-life photoelectric smoke alarms
- Check the **Expiry date** and replace if required
- Check smoke alarms are clean and free of dust, cobwebs, etc. to avoid false alarms

You are **FOUR TIMES** more likely to survive a house fire if you have a working smoke alarm. **Call Craig Ritchie 027470538 if you require help**with smoke alarms

EMERGENCY ACCESS

When you require emergency services Fire/Medical there are a number of things you can do to make sure we arrive as quickly as possible:

- RAPID Number make sure this is large & visible at your road gate entrance.
- House Identification if you have more than one house down a driveway please clearly identify each house with a letter eg A, B or C, in order from the beginning of the driveway.
- Keep Driveways/Access ways clear of trees.
