Nature of Science: 67%

Items relate to science communication and making links between scientific knowledge and everyday decisions and actions. (NZ Curriculum)



Physical World: 24%

The physical world items provide explanations for a wide range of physical phenomena, including light, sound, heat, electricity, magnetism, waves, forces, and motion, united by the concept of energy, which is transformed from one form to another without loss. (NZ Curriculum)




Material World: 40%

The material world items involve the study of matter and its changes. Pupils use their understanding of the fundamental properties of chemistry to make sense of the world around them. (NZ Curriculum)



Planet Earth & beyond: 78%

Planet earth and beyond items are about the interconnecting systems and processes of the Earth and other parts of the solar system. (NZ Curriculum)



Living World: 13%

The living world items are about living things and how they interact with each other and the environment. (NZ Curriculum)

Items Completed represents the percentage of items attempted:

Item Accuracy represents the percentage of attempted items answered correctly:

- High = more that 85% accurate.
- Medium High = between 66% and 85% accurate.
- Medium = between 46% and 65% accurate.
- Medium Low = between 30% and 45% accurate.
- Low = less than 30% accurate.
