Managers meeting: Fri 4th October – 9.00am Foster Park

Rules: Unless specifically stated, FIFA rules to apply at all times.

- **Fields size:** 55x35m, retreat line @ 30%, 4-5x2m goals. Ball size 4.
- **Access to fields:** Only players, coaches and managers are allowed inside the roped off areas. This will be strictly monitored.
Warm up in designated areas only - not on Festival fields.
- **Retreating Line:** Retreating line rule applies.
- **Team size:** 7v7, max 10 players per team.
- **Substitutions:** Rolling. Players must wait until substituted player is off the field, new player to enter at half way mark. Coaches and substitutes to remain in marked technical areas.
Each player is to play as a minimum the equivalent of 2 full games during the course of the Festival.
- **Game duration:** All matches are 2 x 20 minutes, with max 5 min half time.
All matches start and stop by central hooter signal.

Pool games – no winner required

In placement games (ie 5-8,9-12,13-16) - If the result is a draw at full time then straight into penalty shootout.

Penalty shootout - 3 penalties, then sudden death.

In Quarter Finals, Semi Finals and Final

If the result is a draw at full time in the quarter finals, the game continues into 5 min extra time each way.

If scores are still level a penalty shootout will follow.

- **Spectacles:** It is the parents /caregivers' responsibility to ensure only approved sport spectacles are worn.
- **Jewellery:** No jewellery of any sort to be worn.
- **Referees:** Due to the large number of games at our Festival, we have a number of Youth Referees assisting us over the 3 days under guidance and mentoring of a Referee Advisor.

This is also to grow the number of qualified Referees so badly needed in the game.

In addition and especially on day one we may require a number of matches to be refereed (1 half each) by each team's coach/manager.

Please play your part in supporting them throughout the Festival and keep it Positive [+].

It is important to understand and appreciate that the 10th grade Festival is set as a pre-cursor for 'proper' 11th grade South Island Tournaments next year.

The primary driver for the Festival is for kids to have fun, continue to fall in love with the beautiful game, and get a taste of a large sporting event and meet new friends along the way.

Play hard & play fair – but remember *the town clock is not at stake*.

Important Notes

Prize Giving: Sunday 6th October immediately after the last Final match.

All three Festivals will have:

- Medals for each player and perpetual Trophy to the Winning Team.
- Medals for each player of the runner-up team.
- Most Valuable Player for each team (voted by their team).
- Trophy for the **Most Sporting Team and Supporters**.

Food/Drink

There will be vendors for tea/coffee on the Park, as well our Club Sausage sizzle and another food trailer.

Team marquees and shelters

With Foster Park's indoor Stadium build starting next year, there is no other shelter available at this time. There is a designated area for team marquees and shelters. (See map in this program and on our App). You may leave these up overnight, but entirely at your own risk.

Medical Services: First Aid assistance is available at the Tournament Control Centre.

Lost Property:

Car Parking:

Festival Format

Seeding

Due to the great number of entries received, in consultation with Mainland Football and Football South we have seeded teams best possible into 3 separate Festivals:

10th Grade Festival - Girls Trophy

10th Grade Festival - Martin Allen Trophy

10th Grade Festival - Jym Findlay Trophy

Girls Trophy

This Festival consists of 2 x round-robins with all teams playing each other twice. Placings are determined as per criteria for the Martin Allen and Jym Findlay Trophy pool matches.

Martin Allen and Jym Findlay Trophies

In pool play (Day 1), 3 points are awarded for a win, 1 point for a draw and 0 points for a loss. Placings are determined according to the following criteria in descending order of importance;

1. Total points
2. Best goal difference
3. Most goals scored
4. Head to head
5. Coin Toss

Following pool play

- The top two teams in each pool advance to Quarter Finals played on day 2.
- Teams placed 3rd & 4th in each pool advance to the Minor Quarter Finals on day 2.
- All teams play their final placings game on Day 3

Retreating Line Key points

- When a team's Goalkeeper receives the ball, they have the choice to wait for the attacking players to drop back behind the retreating line. **If the GK chooses not to wait until all the opposition are behind, then the ball is live.**
- When the Goalkeeper plays the ball out, only upon the first touch of the Goalkeepers team-mate can the attacking player advance over the retreating line.

Coaches and Referees:

- ✓ From the GK receiving the ball, the game should be 'live' within a maximum of 6 seconds, if you use the retreating zone or not. ie. The GK plays quickly OR allows players to set-up for play from the back once the opposition are behind the retreating line.
- ✓ Encourage the players to quickly get behind the retreating line.

- ⊗ **Do not** - Allow the goalkeeper to kick long every time. Encourage playing out from the back.
- ⊗ **Do not** - Put a defender on the goal line whilst the GK takes a goal kick.
- ⊗ **Do not** - Allow your defender receiving the ball to wait until it stops rolling and taking too long. Encourage early touches.

Players receiving the ball within the retreat line will be pulled up by the referee for stationary ball run ups, and a free kick awarded to the opposition to be taken on the retreat line.

- **Offside:** In 7v7 the Retreating Line is also used as the offside line for attacking players
