Enrolment Scheme

Home Zone

All students who live within the home zone described below shall be eligible to enrol at the school.

Starting from the intersection of West Coast Road (SH 73) and Chattertons Road;

- North along the eastern side only of Chattertons Road to McLeans Island Road
- North along the eastern side only of Mclean's Island Road to 895 McLeans Island Road
- · East along both sides of McLeans Island Road to Pound Road
- South along Pound Road to Ryans Road
 - o Including 371 McLeans Island Road and Savills Road
- East along Ryans Road to Russley Road (SH1)
 - o Including Grays Road between Ryans Road and George Bellew Road
- South along the western side only of Russley Road (SH1) to Yaldhurst Road (SH73)
- West along the northern side only of Yaldhurst Road (SH73) to Sir John McKenzie Avenue
- · South along the western side only of Sir John McKenzie Avenue to Furlong Street
- From the Sir John McKenzie Avenue / Furlong Street intersection, west to the Ferdinand Terrace / Philippe Avenue intersection
 - o Including all addresses on Ferdinand Terrace
- South along the western side only of Philippe Avenue to Bernice Crescent
- South along the western side only of Bernice Crescent to address #12
- South to Buchanans Road
- East along the southern side only of Buchanans Road to the Transmission Lines
- South along the western side only of the Transmission Lines to Roberts Road
- West along Roberts Road to Pound Road
- South along Pound Road to the northern boundary of the Templeton Golf Club
- West along the northern boundary of the Templeton Golf Club to Hasketts Road
- North along the eastern side only of Hasketts Road to Buchanans Road
- West along Buchanans Road to West Coast Road (SH 73)
- West along West Coast Road (SH 73) up to 377 West Coast Road (SH 73)
- West along the north side only of West Coast Road (SH 73) to Chattertons Road

Addresses on both sides of boundary roads are considered in-zone unless specified otherwise.

Each year, applications for enrolment in the following year from in-zone students will be sought by a date that will be published by public notice in a medium appropriate to the area served by the school. This will enable the board to assess the number of places that can be made available to students who live outside the home zone.

Special Programmes

This priority category is not applicable at this school because the school does not run a Special programme approved by the Secretary.

Out of Zone Enrolments

Applications for enrolments will be processed in the order of priority specified in the <u>Education and Training Act 2020</u>.

Before the application deadline associated with each pre-enrolment period, a Board must, by public notice in a medium appropriate to the area served by the school:

- confirm the already advertised dates for the receipt of applications and for the holding of the ballot.
- state the likely number of out of zone places that remain available.

If there are more applicants in any priority group than there are places available, selection within the priority group will be by ballot conducted in accordance with <u>instructions by the Secretary</u>, under Schedule 20, Clause 3 (1) of the Education and Training Act 2020. Parents will be informed of the date of any ballot by public notice in a medium appropriate to the area served by the school.

Applicants may be required to give proof of address or sibling relationship.

The guidelines for development and operation of enrolment schemes are issued under Schedule 20, Clause 3 (3) of the Education and Training Act 2020 for the purpose of describing the basis on which the Secretary's powers in relation to enrolment schemes will be exercised.
