ANZAC DAY Refuse and Recycling Waiau, Rotherham, Culverden, Waikari and Hawarden

On week commencing 22 April, rubbish, and recycling will be collected one day later than normal on Friday 26 April.

Please remember:

- Only Hurunui District Council bags will be collected; these are sold via Hawarden Four Square, Waiau Hardware, Culverden Four Square and Rotherham Store.
- Bags must be securely tied and at the kerbside by 8am as collection times may vary to normal. The crew is unable to return to collect bags placed out late.
- Refuse bags must not exceed 15kg.
- Bags split prior to the crew's arrival and non-official bags will not be collected.
- Bundles of card will not be collected but can be recycled via the transfer station.

The following are accepted via Council's recycling bags:

- Newspapers, magazines, catalogues, leaflets, and telephone directories.
- Clean cardboard, including greetings cards and egg boxes.
- Clean food and drink cans.
- Rigid plastic bottles and small containers, types 1, 2 and 5 - with lids removed.

All transfer stations are closed on ANZAC DAY, 25 April 2024.

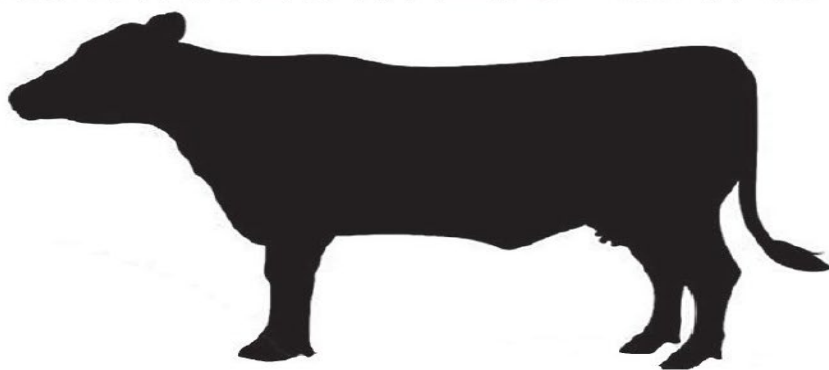
