2019 Board of Trustees Parent Elections St Thomas of Canterbury College

Nominations will soon be invited for the election of five parent representatives to the Board of Trustees. Nomination forms will be posted by Friday, 10 May, to enable you to put your name forward as a candidate in the forthcoming Board of Trustees election, or to nominate someone else as a candidate.

Who can be nominated as a parent elected trustee?

- All caregivers of existing St Thomas of Canterbury College students.
- Anyone, providing they are nominated by someone on the school roll.
- A person can self nominate and be the nominator if they are on the school roll. Both sections must be signed.

Nomination procedure

Complete the nomination form, including the necessary signatures. Complete the candidate's contact details including their address and telephone numbers (home and mobile), and post, hand deliver or email the form to the returning officer at the address shown below. If emailed, promptly make arrangements to get the originals to the returning officer at St Thomas of Canterbury College.

Nominations close at noon on Friday, 24 May, 2019

As a candidate, you are invited to submit a brief (up to 400 words) statement. It is the candidate's responsibility to ensure the signed candidate's statement is received by the returning officer by noon on Friday, 24 May, 2019.

Voting Roll

A copy of the voting roll is available for inspection at the school office during normal school hours. If an election is required, voting papers will be posted by Wednesday, 29 May, 2019. The poll closes at noon on Friday, 7 June, 2019.

The results will be made available at the school and also published in the 'The Press'.
