MOBILE GROOMING TRAILER

Waiau, North Canterbury

Hi, my name is Valda and I am a Waiau local. I have recently changed my profession from truck driving to dog grooming as I saw there was a need for this service in our area. I have always had a love for dogs and have two of my own, Falcon and Harley.

We built this trailer so that I could access more of our neighboring towns as well. It contains a purpose built stainless steel bath with a high pressure water system and a height adjustable floor in it for the little ones. They then walk up onto my grooming platform and everywhere they go they will be secured there.

When dogs are a lot longer in the coats than they normally would be I do pre-grooms first. This can mean the grooming takes a bit longer than usual, as I brush out the full coat then do a long clip on them to get rid of some excess hair! This makes it a lot easier to clean the coat that is left and also it makes it a lot easier to dry them too! Then they are bathed and dried and then the finish groom. Toe nail trims and ear cleaning are available.

There are always treats being given to good pooches as long as they are allowed them, and always lots of cuddles along the way!!!

I have crates to keep dogs in if you have more than one to bring at once and keep them safe, and they can also see what is going on from there. Thankyou for supporting me on this new adventure!!!

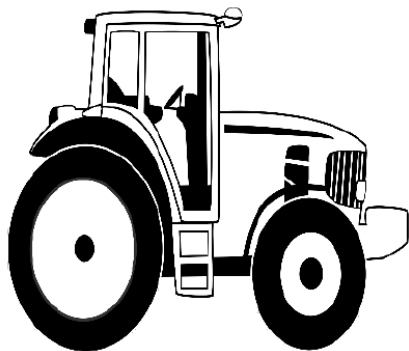
