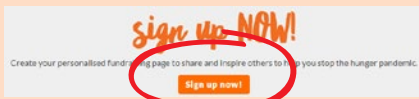

How do I sign up for the World Vision 40 Hour Famine online?

All you need is an email address
– it only takes a few minutes!

- 1 Visit 40hour.org.nz and click **Sign up now**.



- 2 Follow the simple steps to get started and set up your fundraising page.
- 3 You can then personalise your page, your fundraising goal and share your page with your friends and family.
- 4 If you're part of a school, church or team, make sure you connect to their page when you sign up – see below for how to do this!

How can I edit my fundraising details?




You can edit your fundraising page in My World Vision any time during your fundraising.

- 1 Head to 40hour.org.nz and click **Sign in** on the top right of the page.
 - 2 Under **My fundraising**, select the page that you want to edit.
 - 3 Select the **Edit page** button.
- 
- 4 Here you can update your goal, mission statement, cover image and profile picture.
 - 5 Save your changes and your updates will go up on your page straight away.

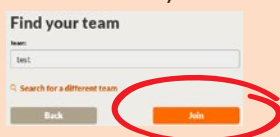
How do I join a school, church or team?

Joining a team is a great way to fundraise!

If you already have a fundraising page:

- 1 Head to 40hour.org.nz and click **Sign in** on the top right of the page.
- 
- 2 Select **My fundraising**.
- 
- 3 Select the fundraising page you want to connect with your team.
 - 4 Under the team section, select **Search teams**.
- 
- 5 Type in the name of the team you want to join.

- 6 Join your team!



If you don't have a fundraising page yet:

- 1 Find your team's fundraising page.
- 2 Select **Join this Team**.
- 3 Follow the prompts to set up your own fundraising page, which will automatically connect to the team.
