Keeping safe at KidsFest

The caregiver status for these events is listed as *Conditions apply, please talk to the event provider directly regarding the caregiver options.

If your child is going to an event that doesn't require your attendance please ensure your child is happy and comfortable before you leave. Make sure the event provider has your contact details should they need to get hold of you. Likewise, make sure you keep their contact details handy.

When attending an event please make sure your child is prepared with appropriate clothing, drink bottle and a small snack.
