Site Welfare

We have arrived.

It has been a very busy past few weeks as we have been frantically preparing the site for the delivery of our site containers. Creating concrete pads for the containers to be positioned on, power & water supply for the toilets and drainage for the waste to be taken way have all been installed.

Outside the welfare facilities there is 1.4 kms of deer fence that encompasses the construction sites (Whare, Junior and Senior buildings) that are now up, securing the site and has allowed us to begin with the haul roads. The haul roads are nearly completed, leaving us a very large mound of dirt, which could be dubbed thee Mt Rototuna
