I am in the process of locking in a couple of weekend dates for our school ski programme. Unfortunately, Round Hill are not offering the cheaper school prices this year, so we are planning to go to Mt Dobson instead. This will work out at roughly \$38 per child, per day for lesson, gear hire and lift pass, and not including a PTA subsidy of \$20 per Waimate Main School child.

Every class will perform a song, and every whanau group will team up to present a song. We will also perform a kapa haka item and a whole school song, giving us around 10 items in total. #### School Trips/EOTC

We are in the process of finalizing two school trips this term. One of the trips will be a road trip out to the fossil museum at Duntroon, followed by lunch at Elephant Rocks, and a quick visit to the Maori rock drawings on the way back to school. The other trip will be a farm visit out to the Guys dairy farm to experience milking and calf feeding. We are also trying to organise tours of either the Fonterra or Oceania processing plants on the same day. These trips will lead in nicely to our pet day on the final day of term.
