Aupaki Tech Fest 2019

This year, students in Years 5 to 8 will have the opportunity to participate in the Aupaki Tech Fest.

Tech Fest is a two-day technology hui held in the Sumner School Hall for approximately 90 students from the seven schools that make up the Aupaki Kāhui Ako. Each attendee will choose a workshop to participate in for the 2 days, where they will work with a teacher and approximately 11 other students. The workshops will appeal to a range of children's skills and talents such as technology, art, music, film, writing, engineering, creativity and problem solving.

plus a showcase for whānau between 1:30pm and 2:30pm on Wednesday 22 May

Where: Sumner School Hall

Cost: \$50. This cost includes a Tech-Fest t-shirt

Places are limited so please think carefully before choosing to register your interest. Children will need to enjoy thinking creatively, working co-operatively, using IT equipment, exploring new ideas and solving problems.
