Exiting the tourist circuit to experience life as it really is in villages, schools, health centres, squatter settlements, observe subsistence farming, fishing, crafts, and reside within an orphanage campus.

Be Inspired

Experience the heart of Fiji and even become inspired to consider developing partnership projects to support those living in our Pacific neighbourhood.

There are opportunities for church/parish/groups to partner with specific mission needs with like-minded churches and projects in Fiji.

Over the past 10 years some examples of what our groups have supported include: providing medical equipment for hospitals, educational materials and sports equipment for schools, we've purchased fishing row boats for villages, established pre-school learning, a tour member has started a 'bra ministry', also we've provided sewing machines for the orphanage and currently building the first mud brick house in Fiji – as an alternative affordable housing option for poorer or remote villages.

Nuts and Bolts

- Tour restricted to 20 seniors from throughout NZ. (Don't delay responding if you're interested!)
- 10-day tour in August 2023 (8 days Suva/2 days Nadi resort).
- We provide team training and cultural learning prior to departure for each group.
- Team is hosted and escorted by Fijian tour guides-chaperones.
- Suva accommodation is located at St Christopher's orphanage campus. An exclusive hostel residence available for groups with twin-share and a few single rooms with meals provided by our Fijian catering team.

Our Tour Package




Tour Fee \$3,490
