SOPHIE!!

A big congratulations to Sophie Ockwell who competed at the Canterbury Primary Schools Swimming Sports yesterday. Sophie qualified for the 50m Freestyle event and achieved an awesome result. Well done Sophie - we are very proud of you!

During Term 1, our Year 11 PE students have been out surfing and mountain biking as a way to complete their assessment standard to display responsible behaviours to keep themselves and others safe in these environments.

They have enjoyed mountain biking at Hanmer Springs in the forests, learning the key techniques to safely ride the downhill tracks at the Christchurch Adventure Park and doing "speed" laps at McLeans Island in training for their assessment.

Surfing at Sumner was a blast with all students experiencing "standing" and "surfing" the waves at some stage over the three sessions. Waves started off small and got bigger as we went. All students made great progress in the art of surfing while also successfully displaying the behaviours required for the assessment.

IMPETIGO / SCHOOL SORES

Impetigo is a common contagious infection of the skin that is in the community at present. It is very common in children, but can also be present in adults. Caused by 2 bacteria, it gets into breaks in the skins surface and causes blisters that transform into weeping then crusty scabs. Usually noticeable on hands and faces, but can be in other areas of the body too. The blisters can itch or feel like they are burning.


They are easily spread by itching, touching, sharing towels or clothing and it is really important that you see you GP for advice and assessment if you think you or your child may have it.

You can clean and soothe the scabs by doing bleach or vinegar baths, then keep the areas covered with a dressing or a bandage until treatment begins to work.

Once a cream or antibiotic is prescribed the children should not attend preschool, school, sports or swimming until 24 hours after the start of treatment to prevent further spread amongst peers or family.

If you are concerned, give your GP a call, but keep an eye out for them. They spread quickly.
