## SWIMMING POOL RULES AND SAFETY GUIDELINES


The following rules are for the safety and protection of you and your family. **PLEASE OBSERVE THEM.** The Cheviot Area School Board of Trustees will not be responsible for any accidents, loss of life or property.


### YOUR CHILD REMAINS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY AT ALL TIMES


 **DO NOT SWIM ALONE.** Children under 16 years of age **MUST** be supervised by a person aged 18 years or older at all times


 For the safety of the public, gate must be **locked** after entry to and exit of the pool

 Animals are prohibited in the pool area


 Keys are **not transferable.** Keys are not to be shared between families. Key holders are welcome to bring visitors to swim provided the non member fee of \$2.00 per swimmer (maximum \$10.00 per family) is paid into the honesty box provided.

 Key holders must be 18 years or over


 Pool open hours are 9am -6pm daily. (due to 3 hourly chemical testing requirements testing occurs at 9am, 12 midday, 3pm)


 When using any equipment in the pool or swimming generally, please be considerate of other pool users


 Suitable swimming attire must be worn at all times


 No glass or sharp objects are permitted in the pool area


 **Alcohol and drugs are prohibited.** Drinking or eating in the pool will not be tolerated


 No running or jumping around the pool area. No dunking or other dangerous activities permitted


 For the safety of your children there is to be **no standing** on the top side of the pool nearest the changing sheds. There is to be **no entry or exit** over this side, for the same reason

 Do not use the pool if suffering from a skin infection or within 14 days of suffering diarrhoea (Health Reg. 5/98 Code 9037). Babies must be wearing appropriate swimming nappies to use the pool. If faeces are found, please notify the School Caretaker 027 3199 790. Vacate and lock the pool immediately.

 The pool is closed to the public during the **school term** from **9.00am to 3.05pm daily** and on **Mondays** from **9.00am -10.00am** for cleaning

 **Wednesday and Friday** from **9am – 10am** is reserved for the mature members of our community

 The **pool is closed** to all in the evenings from 6.00 pm onwards (due to 3 hourly chemical testing requirements) or when the **pool is covered** or the **closed sign** is up. Anyone on the premises at these times will be trespassing. Unlawful entry will not be tolerated.

 In case of a medical emergency call 111, if no phone available the nearest is at the Cheviot Trust Hotel

***Anyone found not obeying these rules will be asked to leave the pool area and will have their key confiscated.***

### **KEYS**

Keys are available for seasonal hire from the Cheviot Area School office for \$75.00 plus \$25.00 bond refundable on prompt return of the key at the end of the season (approx. April 2020). If the key is not returned within one month of the end of the season this will result in the loss of the bond. Keys for the following season will not be issued if previous season's key has not been returned. Lost keys will incur an additional replacement fee of \$25.00.

**Temporary Keys are not available this year.**

Casual swimmers may enter with a key holder and pay into the honesty box provided ~ \$2.00 per swimmer. These swimmers must leave when the key holder leaves.
