Criteria

Any coach interested in advancing their coaching knowledge and contributing back to the coaching of NZIHF hockey.

Registration Criteria

The player must be registered with the NZIHF and their Regional Association in 2018.

Cost

The NZIHF will pay 100% of the coach's flights.

Once at the camp, all meals and activities are paid for by the IIHF.

Supervision

The coach will supervise the travel of the two female players travelling to the camp.
