

Here's how to draw, first in pencil, the Triquetra symbol, sometimes known as the Trinity Knot, an ancient symbol used in Celtic knot designs. It can symbolize Earth, Air and Water on which all living forms depend. You start with an equilateral triangle. Then you'll probably need a protractor or compass for the curves. (Note: The circle in 6 is often left out.) The final step before colouring it in, is to erase some of the overlapping segments of the knot and circle to give the symbol the look of being interlaced.
