

Will I even be eligible?...

You may be able to get an OSCAR Subsidy if:

- you're the main carer of a dependent child
- you're a New Zealand citizen or permanent resident
- your family is on a low or middle income.

You also need to be in one of these situations:

- working, studying or on an approved training course
- involved in an activity that Work and Income has asked you to do a shift worker who works nights
- seriously ill or disabled caring for a child in hospital or for a child you get the Child Disability Allowance for.
- You can't get the OSCAR Subsidy if the child's other parent or caregiver can take care of the child.

It also depends on how much you and your partner earn.

This represents the amount of families in Aotearoa that from the 1st of April will now be entitled to receive a childcare subsidy!!

It is well worth finding out if you are entitled to receive something!

Important to Note:

To receive your OSCAR subsidy from the day your child starts the programme, you need to submit your application to WINZ **before** your child's first day.

This is especially important during the school holidays.

Tip: It pays to plan ahead...be prepared, book all the days in that you will require care for ahead of time.



The child or young person must:

- Normally live in New Zealand
- Be at school
- Be under 14 (or under 18 if you get a Child Disability Allowance for them)
- Be attending an approved OSCAR programme for at least 3 hours a week.

Approved Programmes Include:

- Before school
- After school
- Holiday programmes and camps.

All MASH Programmes are OSCAR Approved.
